The Sidhwan Group of Institutions, situated in Sidhwan Khurd, Ludhiana, has a rich and inspiring legacy rooted in the noble cause of women's education. The journey began in 1909 when Bhai Narain Singh, a visionary educationist and philanthropist, started educating four girls under a mulberry tree in his courtyard at a time when female education was uncommon in undivided Punjab. Deeply committed to this cause, he dedicated 20 bighas of land and established the Sri Guru Hargobind Ujagar Hari Trust, donating his entire property for the promotion of education. Inspired by the desire to educate his daughter, Bibi Harparkash Kaur, after the untimely demise of his son, Kaka Ujagar Singh, Bhai Narain Singh laid the foundation of an educational movement that has grown remarkably over the years. What started as a small primary school with four students has today evolved into a distinguished group of institutions imparting quality education to more than 5,000 students.

Under the dynamic leadership of Mata Ram Kaur, Padma Shri Bibi Harparkash Kaur, S. Mohinder Singh Sidhwan, and other visionary leaders, the institutions witnessed significant academic and infrastructural expansion. Major milestones in this journey include the upgradation of the school to a High School in 1934, the establishment of a Degree College in 1950, a Basic Training College in 1956, the introduction of M.Ed. classes in 1969, the establishment of Guru Hargobind Public School in 1977, G.H.G. Institute of Law in 2006, and most recently, G.H.G. Institute of Pharmacy in the academic session 2025-26. Today, the Sidhwan Group of Institutions continues to uphold its century-old tradition of academic excellence, social commitment, and holistic development while carrying forward the noble vision of its founders.

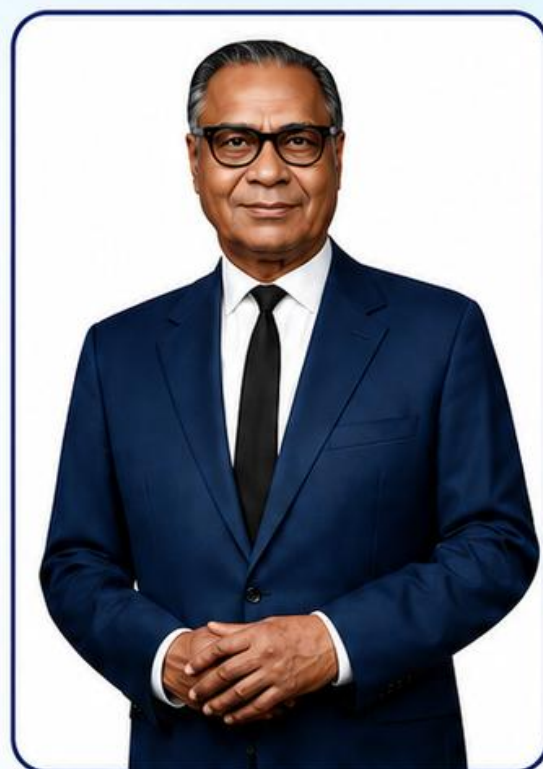
A TRIBUTE TO PROF. MAHADEVA LAL SCHROFF

Educational Qualification: All those candidates who have passed 10+2 examination from any Board recognized or established by Central / State Government through a legislation and member of Council of School Education (COBSE) as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics / Biology as optional subjects individually.



Minimum Marks: General category candidates must score at least 45% aggregate; reserved categories (SC/ST) require 40%.



Age Limit: Candidates must be at least 17 years old on or before December 31st of the admission year.
